- **Noted - members advised that details of this consultation are available via the NYCC website.**
- 5.1.2 NYCC County Archives – Conditions for deposit of items for storage. Discussion of need for further archiving of GPC documents.
- **Members made aware of the increasing number of historical documents and ledgers etc. now more than ten years old which would be better stored safely and under controlled conditions. Clerk has investigated the possibility of adding these items to the documents held with County Archives at Northallerton and has determined that this can be done at no cost to the council. Members agreed to allow these documents etc. to be transferred to the Archives at the Clerks discretion. Clerk to make necessary arrangements.**
- 5.1.3 Damage to verges and garden wall by NYCC/Contractor snowplough at Houlsyke.
- **Members informed of action taken in response to information provided by Cllr NH regarding damage caused to the verges and to the garden wall of a residents cottage at Houlsyke by the actions of a tractor mounted snowplough during the recent snowfall. NYCC Highways were informed of the incident and have promised to investigate and report back to GPC as to any action to be taken in remedying this damage.**
- 5.1.4 Roadside litter issues in Fryupdale and surrounding areas.
- **Cllr CH raised the matter of increasing amounts of litter which are accumulating along country roads and in the hedgerows and of the lack of any apparent interest in removing this from the local authorities concerned. This problem is getting worse and members would like to see action being taken to relieve this problem. Clerk to contact NYCC to determine whether there is any established way of dealing with the problem.**

## 7. MATTERS OF INTEREST RAISED BY MEMBERS

### 7.1 Highways Issues.

- Woodocks Bank, Glaisdale - Grit bin demolished by impact with vehicle.
- Prospect House, Fryup - drainage issues (previously reported by GPC) still have not been dealt with. Recent icing up of the water draining across the road at this point has since contributed to a road accident. This issue should be prioritised by NYCC for action.

### 7.2 Parish seating.

- The seat at the entrance to Millers wood is now in a dangerous condition and should be removed to prevent potential injury to the public. Cllrs CF & SWT to arrange for removal asap.
- Seat in front of Prospect House, Lealholmside is very difficult to access and members are of the opinion that it should be moved to a new location or access steps be cut into the roadside banking. Both alternative solutions to be examined.
- Seat opposite the Arncliffe Arms is in very poor condition and should be earmarked for replacement asap.
