5.1.1 **RAY** – Community and Household emergency planning event.

- **Members advised of proposed workshops (4 off) planned by RAY and run at venues across the county to raise awareness and to assist parish councils and community groups to create and set up a Community Emergency Plan for their area. Such plans are invaluable in times of stress and upheaval experienced by many during natural disasters and other emergency situations. (eg widespread flooding, catastrophic events such as road/rail/air accidents involving many people) The workshops will cover many topics such as storage of sand-bags ; setting up a ‘safe place’ refuge for those needing to leave their homes ; setting up a system for checking on the most vulnerable members of the community likely to have been affected (the elderly, infirm, isolated, for eg.) and the creating of personal emergency routines for every household and how best to liaise/ interface with the emergency services.**
- **RAY is to set out plans for these workshops soon and details will be posted on our noticeboards and on the council web-site.**

5.1.2 **Caring Together** – Whitby Rural Activities project opportunity.

- **Information received from ‘Ryedale Carers Support’ requesting an opportunity to attend a council meeting to present their services and inform of a new project to make available the services of a ‘Rural Activities Co-ordinator’ to be responsible for setting up and running monthly activities aimed at the older and more isolated residents living in the rural areas of Scarborough and Whitby.**
- **Members agreed that the project was interesting and worthy of support and agreed that an invitation should be offered to attend in advance of a suitable PC meeting to receive the presentation. Clerk to issue an invitation.**
