1. **MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING** were presented, agreed and signed as a true record.
2. **MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES**
  - 2.1 Police report – attached.
    - **Report contents noted - no police presence available to attend the meeting.**
  - 2.2 Parish seating – reconvening of Millennium Committee – update, Cllr CF.
    - **Cllr Featherstone has advised that the remaining members of the original Millennium Committee who are still contactable have agreed to convene to formally pass ownership of the Millennium bench at Glaisdale on to the Parish Council. The committee will formulate a letter of transfer of ownership to the benefit of the Parish Council and once this has been received and the council has formally accepted ownership then the bench can be included on the council asset register and be included within the council insurance Public Liability responsibility.**
  - 2.3 Inappropriate use of 'Back Lane' Glaisdale – update, Cllr RN.
    - **Cllr RN has made contact with the local resident whose children were believed to be the responsible individuals causing the complaints in this case. The matter will be dealt with by their parents and councillors were happy to accept this undertaking as being an end to the matter.**
  - 2.4 Houlsyke refuse bin proposals – update of SBC viewpoint.
    - **Members informed of information obtained from SBC as to the possible use of one or two large 4-wheeled super bins of the type used for commercial waste. Whilst SBC would be prepared to empty such bins, they would be subject to normal commercial waste collection rates which amount to approx. £863.00 per bin per year. Members were not sure that residents would not continue to use their own personal bins as well - especially if the additional costs were passed on to them - which would mean that the street scene would be cluttered still further with the addition of the large commercial bins. The matter was closed without a course of action being agreed.**
