MINUTES OF GLAISDALE PARISH COUNCIL MEETING held at The Robinson Institute, Glaisdale, on Thursday 15th November 2012.

1. **MINUTES OF OCTOBER MEETING** were presented, agreed & signed as a true record.

2. **MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES**

2.1 Police attendance and report.

Incidents of note within the Parish:

- 24th October - suspicious males with small white van - VRM NL07ZDY - loitering in private property areas on Low Wood lane, Lealholm. Males challenged who stated they were looking for Holly (tree branches?). Possibly genuine.
- 25th October - report of overnight theft of metal items from allotment in Glaisdale. Items stolen include 2 x engines ; a gearbox ; 6 metal props ; cast iron spouting and steel lintels. Enquiries ongoing.
- 25th October - Report of overnight theft of Quad bike from Stonebeck Gate Farm, Fryup. As the vehicle was not road-legal there were no registration marks or serial numbers available which will make identification of any found stolen quad bike difficult to match.
- 9th November - At approx 21.15hrs call received from resident of Fryupdale reporting a suspicious vehicle, a Suzuki Vitara - VRM S990NNK - all mudded up and travelling around the area. Officers attended as the vehicle was known to be linked with crime. Vehicle not located at that time but at 22.15hrs a call from the same resident reported that a quad bike had been stolen. The vehicle was tracked and eventually stopped in the Stokesley area where a male was arrested. On a search of the arrested persons address further stolen items were recovered.

4.5 2013/14 Draft budget proposals.

- Draft Budget proposals for 2013/14 presented to members for comment and discussion. Figures were agreed as presented with a proviso that the verge cutting work should be limited. The number of hours to be worked will be capped so as to give a nil increase on 2012/13 expenditure.
- Similar consideration may be applied to the Grass-cutting contract for 2013/14.
- Final budget to be presented to members at the January meeting.

4.6 ** Request for financial support - Esk Moors Active Ltd.

- Members received a request for financial support from Esk Moors Active organisation which is planning a venture next year aimed at increasing the usage by Lealholm and Glaisdale residents. Members were supportive of this organisation and the work it does in this area and so agreed to donate the sum of £75. Proposal to offer payment made by Cllr MF, seconded Cllr RN. All members in agreement. Chq 100782 issued in payment. (£137 expenditure.)
