MINUTES OF GLAISDALE PARISH COUNCIL MEETING held via Video Conferencing session on Thursday 18th February 2021.

2. **MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES**
 - 2.1 Police reports – January 2021 (None received for Jan 2021)

 - 2.2 Glaisdale footpath proposals – alternative route. (See Agenda Papers)
 - Members advised of proposals drawn up between GPC/DCL/NYMNPA regarding provisional routing of footpath which avoids using the dangerous bend on Woodworks bank and traverses common land area to the side of the main road, exiting opposite the tennis courts. Members agreed that these proposals form a good basis for further action and agreed that the route should be promoted as the preferred option. Both of the other parties involved in this project (DCL / NYMNPA) have voiced their support for this option and NYMNPA have indicated that there may be a possibility of further grant aid for this work. Cllrs MH & RN to continue actions as agreed.
 - 2.3 Glaisdale Tennis Court improvement works.
 - Cllr MH advised members that drainage works to the rear of the tennis courts is due to commence next week by the contractors engaged. (Nobles)

- After some discussion regarding this request to assist with further funding towards maintenance of the Lealholm 'Roll of Honour' scroll members agreed that a small donation to this work would be appropriate and that the sum of £50.00 be offered. Cllr CF proposed payment, seconded Cllr KA, all members in agreement.
- Clerk to check with the Lealholm War Memorial Committee to see if funds can be transferred via bank transfer rather than cheque in order to avoid necessity of getting cheques signed in the current circumstances.

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7. MATTERS OF INTEREST RAISED BY MEMBERS

7.1 Highways Issues

- Numerous road surface defects require attention throughout the parish due mainly to the recent winter weather. NYCC to be informed and requested to urge some already reported and overdue works.
- Cllr RN raised the issue of lack of parking in Glaisdale village due to existence of yellow line restrictions and the enforcement of legislation regarding parking on footpaths and common land near to Mitre Cottages. Members agreed that this is a long-standing issue and there appears to be no easy or likely solution in the short term. Members reminded that the layby opposite the village shop in Glaisdale was provided, in part, to compensate householders who had yellow lines installed outside their properties on High Terrace and that perhaps the problem is exacerbated by the fact that many households now have more than one vehicle for which there is no parking provision.
- Streetlamp No1 at entrance to Thornhill View, Glaisdale not lit. NYCC deny responsibility for this unit. Investigations ongoing.
